Pathways to Freedom Course

Our 24-week intensive online course has become an integral part of the anti-human trafficking network of providers.

- Partnership with **10** safe homes across the country
- **22** graduates in 2024
- **89** new survivors served
- **40** current active alumni
- **287% Year-Over-Year Growth**

Case Management & Advocate Services

In 2024, our case management & staff mentor service continued to provide essential support to survivors through dedicated, trained advocate mentors. Each client is matched with a caring mentor who provides:

- Experienced guidance through life transitions and challenges

Alumni Scholarship Program



Our scholarships support diverse educational paths, spanning vocational training, higher education, and professional certification programs. Graduates are eligible to apply for up to \$3,000 toward education and/or job training.

Total Scholarships Approved: **11**
